



TEXAS BOOK FESTIVAL TO HOST READING ROCK STARS WITH ACCLAIMED AUTHORS AT CUNNINGHAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ON DECEMBER 1

Texas Book Festival to Donate 2,000 Books to Houston Students with Reading Rock
Stars Author Presentations

WHAT: The Texas Book Festival will host one of its Houston Reading Rock Stars presentations on Friday, December 1, at Cunningham Elementary School. Beginning at 8:05 a.m., the school will host three authors — Lulu Delacre, bilingual, award-winning author and illustrator of Olinguito A to Z; Nate Ball, host of PBS Kids series Design Squad Global and author of Alien in my Pocket series and Let's Investigate with Nate series; and Diana López, author of novels Ask My Mood Ring How I Feel, Choke, and Confetti Girl.

The Texas Book Festival's Reading Rock Stars literacy program brings books to life for children in low-income schools by inviting authors and illustrators into classrooms with entertaining presentations that inspire students to read, write, and create. Thanks to support from sponsors, including H-E-B Tournament of Champions, Texas College Savings Plan, and Texas Capital Bank, the Texas Book Festival also gives each student an autographed copy of the presenting author's book and provides the school library with a new set of books by the visiting Reading Rock Stars authors. The Texas Book Festival will donate a total of 720 books to Cunningham Elementary School.

Texas Book Festival will coordinate Reading Rock Stars presentations at four Houston elementary schools with seven participating authors and illustrators. With this latest round of Reading Rock Stars, the Texas Book Festival will have coordinated nearly 390 author visits and provided more than 87,000 books to students in Title I schools across Texas since its inception.
