

TEXAS BOOK FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES TICKETED SESSIONS WITH NELSON DEMILLE AND JACQUES PÉPIN

WHAT: Texas Book Festival is excited to announce additional ticketed author sessions taking place during this year's Festival Weekend. On Saturday, November 5, meet *New York Times* bestselling author Nelson DeMille and culinary legend Jacques Pépin. Both sessions and book signings will take place at Central Presbyterian Church, with tickets on sale now.

Nelson DeMille, author of 7 #1 New York Times bestsellers, will present his new novel, The Maze, at 10:30 a.m. With The Maze, the bestselling author returns with the latest installment of the John Corey novels as Corey is called out of retirement to investigate a string of grisly murders much too close to home.

World-renowned chef and sixteen-time James Beard Award winner, Jacques Pépin, will feature his newest book *Jacques Pépin Art of the Chicken*. The book celebrates his lifelong love of chickens, featuring dozens of his celebrated paintings and more than 50 recipes, along with a treasure trove of poignant and often humorous stories.

DeMille and Pepin join previously announced ticketed session author Janet Evanovich, "the most popular mystery writer alive" (NYT) and author of 42 *New York Times* bestsellers, as she presents her new novel, *Going Rogue* on Sunday, November 6 at 2:30 p.m. With *Going Rogue*, the mega-bestselling author returns with the latest book in her massively popular Stephanie Plum series.
