



TEXAS BOOK FESTIVAL TO DISTRIBUTE MORE THAN 4,200 BOOKS TO 6 RIO GRANDE VALLEY TITLE I ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR READING ROCK STARS PROGRAM

AUSTIN, TX (February 27, 2024) – On February 29 and March 1, Texas Book Festival (TBF) will kick off its annual Reading Rock Stars (RRS) Program in the Rio Grande Valley. Nine celebrated children's authors will present their latest books to students in six Title I schools throughout the Rio Grande Valley as part of this two-day program.

The Reading Rock Stars literacy program enlivens books for children by bringing authors to schools to share stories that ignite curiosity and excitement among young readers and provide memorable experiences to support a lifelong love of reading, writing, and creativity. To celebrate the dynamic bilingual community in the Rio Grande Valley, we are thrilled to feature many bilingual authors and books in both Spanish and English in all of our partner schools.

Author visits are the culmination of several weeks of planning on the part of students, educators, and programmers and end with each student taking home a signed copy of the author's book. Since 2001, TBF has donated 171,446 books to children across Texas through this initiative. The Texas Book Festival Reading Rock Stars Program in the Rio Grande Valley is presented by H-E-B Read 3 and is sponsored by the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley.
